

cat file	Concatenate the file (output the contents).
cd directory	Change (move into) directory.
cd	Change back to home directory.
chmod +x file	Change the mode (permissions) of the file.
cp file1 file2	Copy file 1 to file 2.
grep pattern file[s]	Search for a pattern (get regular expression and print) in files.
ls	List names of files in current directory. Long listing of files in current directory
ls -l	(show size, ownership, permissions, date/time last modified).
man command	Display a manual page that explains the command; send the output to more.
man -k word	Search all man pages for the keyword word.
mkdir directory	Make a directory.
more file	Output the file one screenful at a time; show more when space bar or Return key is pressed.
pwd	Show the present working directory (where you are).
rm file[s]	Remove files. Remove files interactively; prompt for confirmation.

wc file	Show the word count, line count, and character count in a file. Show only the
wc -l file	line count.
